

## **iBB Domestic Payments**

The following information details the transaction charges and maximum execution times for each type of payment made through the iBB Domestic Payments module and iBulk Payments module.

Account transfer within the same entity	A transfer made between your own Accounts within the same company	Immediate – no Cut-off time.	Free
Account transfer between different entities within the same group of companies	A transfer made between Accounts held in different entities within the same group of companies	Immediate – no Cut-off time.	The appropriate automated transaction charge <sup>2</sup> (charged quarterly in arrears)
to another AIB (NI)	A transfer made internally to a beneficiary based in AIB (NI) or Allied Irish Bank (GB)	Immediate – no Cut-off time	The appropriate automated transaction charge <sup>2</sup> (charged quarterly in arrears)
to a beneficiary based in another UK	A payment made to a beneficiary based in another UK financial institution <sup>3</sup>	Same day (subject to beneficiary bank processing times). This is provided that the transfer is made between 7.00am and midnight	The appropriate automated transaction charge <sup>2</sup> (charged quarterly in arrears)
CHAPS	This is typically a high value urgent transfer of funds to another UK financial institution made using the CHAPS system	Same day. This is provided that the transfer is made between 9.30am and 5.25pm	£12.00 (charged when incurred) plus appropriate automated transaction charge <sup>2</sup> (charged quarterly in arrears)
Standing Orders	fixed amount payments in Sterling e.g. monthly to your AIB (NI) Accounts and to	Same day. This is provided that the Standing Order is set up by 8pm on the previous Business Day.	The appropriate automated transaction charge <sup>2</sup> (charged quarterly in arrears)

Please note payments released after the cut-off time will be processed on the next Business Day.

## iBB iBulk Payments module

This module is used to make Bulk direct debit and credit payments within the UK. It is used for Sterling branch based accounts.

Bulk Credits Bacs	payments used to pay multiple beneficiaries	Two Business Days. This is provided that the payment is submitted between 8.00am and 5.30pm	£0.15 per transaction within the file, £2.00 per file submitted plus appropriate automated transaction charge <sup>2</sup> (charged quarterly in arrears).
Bulk Direct Debits	ľ	Two Banking Days. This is provided that the payment is submitted between 8.00am and 5.30pm	£0.15 per transaction within the file, £2.00 per file submitted plus appropriate automated transaction charge² (charged quarterly in arrears)
